Purpose

Duties

- Attend some of the sustainability group meetings.
- Act as primary point of contact to receive agendas, papers and minutes and to communicate appropriate information to others in YFGM.
- To be involved in (and encourage others also to become involved in) key areas of the group's work, in particular organising national face-to-face gatherings (the next one will be in 2018).
- Be on the steering group for the emerging project on 'nurturing our sustainability ministry'.

What you could gain from the role

- A deeper understanding of the working of Britain Yearly Meeting, as an organisation, in particular the sustainability group.
- Developing contacts elsewhere in Britain Yearly Meeting.

Skills required

- An interest to become involved in the group's key areas of work.
- To be able to represent the views of YFGM to the group and of the group back to YFGM.
- Ability to relay information about opportunities for other members of YFGM to become involved in the group's work and to raise awareness of sustainability issues.

Time commitment

- Attend some or all of the four meetings a year, of which so far one has been a two-day, midweek residential at Woodbrooke, and the other three have been planned as midweek days at Friends House.
