

QGSDC Rep

Up to 2 years

Purpose

The Quaker Gender & Sexual Diversity Community (QGSDC) is a fellowship of LGBTQI+ people within the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers) in Britain. YFGM's representative provides a link between QGSDC and YFGM.

Duties

- Representing YFGM's views on matters of common interest to QGSDC
- Reporting back to YFGM on QGSDC's views and activities
- Facilitating liaison between YFGM and QGSDC
- Attending QGSDC committee meetings, national gatherings, and other events as appropriate.

What you could gain

- Experience of working on a committee outside YFGM
- Experience organising events
- Links with other Friends who are part of QGSDC

Skills Required

- An interest in the concerns of LGBT+ Friends
- Communication skills

Time Commitment

Attending 3-4 QGSDC committee meetings per year, optionally up to 2 national gatherings per year, and communication between meetings.

No specific YFGM events are required, but you should remain in contact with YFGM and YFGMers, and report to YFGM at least once a year on the activities of QGSDC (more frequently if there are events of particular interest to YFGM). Reports could be in person or in writing (e.g. in a blog post/TYQ).
