

Media Committee

Up to 3 years, 5 people

Purpose

YFGM's Media Committee produces YFGM's outward facing media. This includes 'The Young Quaker' magazine (TYQ), as well as any other formats the committee feels are worth taking on (e.g. podcasts, social media, etc).

Ideally this gives some voice and space for YFGMers within the Quaker community and wider communities (including some level of outreach/promotion by virtue of spreading our voices - working with Outreach and our Communications Trustee).

Duties

- Varies based on committee ambition, but includes seeking submissions and producing (or finding others to produce) whatever outward facing media the committee chooses to take on.

What you could gain

- Experience of writing, editing, and proofreading articles.
- Insight into some of the interesting things that young Friends in the UK (and potentially further afield) are doing, through seeking out articles, reading submissions, and conducting interviews

Skills Required

- An ability to work well in a team
- A desire to seek out articles and contact writers
- Some ability or desire to learn about proofreading, building media engagement, design & layout, use of publishing software (and other tools for other formats)
- Creativity and a sense of humour!

Time Commitment

The committee should maintain regular contact with each other over the course of the year, and may decide to meet in person if necessary (e.g. at planning weekend). The work is expected to mostly happen between YFGMs.
